ADVANCED CURRICULUM

Phoenix Christian High School offers 8 Advanced Placement courses in the following areas: **American History, American Government, European History, Spanish, Calculus AB & BC, Biology, English Language and Literature.** Students taking AP classes can potentially earn up to 63 college credits. PC also offers Honors classes in English, Science, Math, and Computers. Students can also earn dual enrollment college credit. AP classes, Pre-Calculus, Spanish III, Anatomy/Physiology, and Physics are accelerated classes and carry a weighted grade point value, i.e., A=5.0.

INTERNATIONAL PROGRAM

Phoenix Christian is authorized under Federal law to enroll nonimmigrant alien students. We currently have 34 students from ten countries enrolled at Phoenix Christian High School. Our international students immerse themselves in the American high school experience by joining sports teams, music groups, honors programs, and attending social events. Upon graduation, the International students have incredible opportunities to attend competitive American colleges and universities! This program provides a culturally rich and diverse education for the entire Phoenix Christian community.
