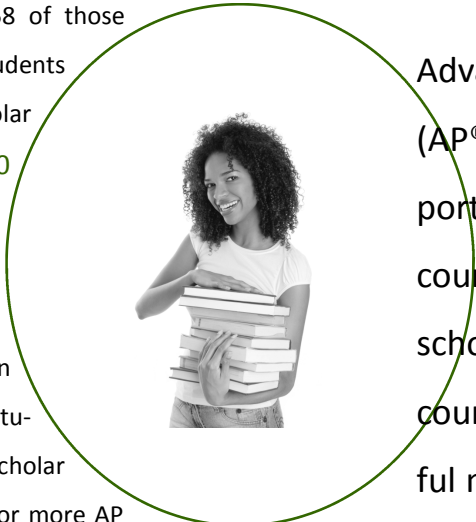


AP® at a glance

In 2010, our students took 103 AP exams and earned a 3 or higher on 58 of those tests! Three of our students earned the honor of AP Scholar with Distinction: **2010 Graduates, Nathan DeLaet, Keith Wilhelm, and senior, Tanner Trapp.** These students earned a 3 or higher on 5 or more AP exams. Four students qualified for the AP Scholar Award by completing three or more AP Exams with grades of 3 or higher. The AP Scholars are **2010 Graduates, David Schneider, Sawyer Trapp, Sarah Varner, and senior, Jeremiah Thomas.** Two students qualified for the AP Scholar with Honor Award by receiving an average score of at least a 3.25 on all AP Exams taken and scores of a 3 or higher on four or more of these exams. The AP Scholars with Honors are **2010 Graduates, Caitlin Bemis and Jacob Hendrix.**

campus. Students enrolled in AP classes will encounter challenging, thought-provoking curriculum that will undoubtedly prepare them for the rigor of college. Each AP

course concludes with the College Board exam. Students scoring between a three and a five may receive credit at their college of choice (see www.collegeboard.com/ap/creditpolicy for each institutions' credit policy). Students taking every AP course could potentially earn up **63 college credits!** Phoenix Christian offers the following Advanced Placement courses: AP Language, AP Literature, AP U.S. History, AP Government, AP European History, AP Calculus AB & BC, AP Biology, and AP Spanish.
