COURSE DESCRIPTION

Art 2 is an extended study of skills learned in Art I. These areas include drawing, oil painting, clay and crafts.

COURSE SCOPE AND SEQUENCE

First Quarter

Drawing 9 Weeks

Key Concepts: Review of Graphite Pencil Techniques, Introduction of Colored Pencil Techniques, Facial Proportions are Self-Portraits, and Illustration Techniques.

Assessments: Graphite Magazine 1/2 Face, Graphite Self-Portrait, Colored Pencil Magazine 1/2 Face, Colored Pencil Self Portrait, Children's Book Illustration, Illustration from Revelation.

Biblical Integration: "Now we see through a glass, darkly; but then face to face..." as Corinthians states, students learn to study and see themselves as we see them, with the reminder that God sees the heart.

Second Quarter

Oil Painting 9 Weeks

Key Concepts: Introduction to Oils using a Limited Palette, Color Theory and Mixing Techniques, Painting Techniques using Knife and Brush.

Assessments: 2- 9" X 12" Knife Paintings, 1- 12" X 16" Brush Painting, Still Life.

Biblical Integration: *Second year is a reminder to all students that God created man with the ability to produce and appreciate beauty. We try to capture that beauty on our canvases.*

Third Quarter

Clay 9 Weeks

Key Concepts: The Art of Mosaic - Tile Cutting, Glazing, Gluing, and Grouting.

Assessment: A 11X 14" Mosaic.

Biblical Integration: As we shape the mosaic pieces out of clay, students will be reminded that God needs to be able to shape us. As pieces are fired in the kiln, Students compare the firing to the trials by fire that we go through in life. It just makes us stronger and more beautiful.

Fourth Quarter

Crafts

9 Weeks

Key Concepts: Hemp Jewelry, Fimo Clay Projects, Candle Making, Scratchboard, Papier-Mache, Block Prints, Glass Tile Mosaics, Origami, Silkscreen, Glass Etching.

Assessments: A Minimum of 5 Different Craft Projects.

Bible Integration: Man's creations are the expressions of his thoughts and emotions. These are all gifts given from God. They are diverse and presented in almost any medium.
