Bible II provides a survey of the 27 books of the New Testament. This includes authorship, dates and places of writing, key themes, identification of important Biblical figures. Christian service and the application of Biblical truth to the life of the present-day Christian are also emphasized.

COURSE SCOPE AND SEQUENCE

First Quarter – Intertestamental Period and the Synoptic Gospels

The Believer's Outline 2 Weeks

Key Concepts: The Nature of God, Evidence for Creation, Reliability of Scripture, Person of Christ, Sin, and Salvation

Assessments: Unit Test, Vocabulary Quiz, Memory Verse Quiz (Malachi 4:5-6), Completion of Believer's Outline.

Intertestamental Period 1 Week

Key Concepts: Alexander the Great, Hellenization, Ptolemaic and Seleucid Empires, Antiochus Epiphanes, Maccabean Revolt, Cleopatra, Pompey

Assessments: Vocabulary Quiz, Timeline.

Synoptic Comparisons / Jewish Sects 2 Weeks

Key Concepts: Compare / Contrast Synoptic Gospels with the Gospel of John. Pharisees, Sadducees, Zealots, Sicarii, Herodians, Essenes

Assessments: Unit test, Theme Paper – Compare / Contrast Jewish Sects.

Gospel According to Matthew 2 Weeks

Key Concepts: The Kingdom of Heaven, Parables, Beatitudes, Prophetic Fulfillment, Messiah, Great Commission.

Assessments: 2 Memory Verse Quizzes (Matthew 27:37, Matthew 28:19-20), Parables Chart, Vocabulary Quiz.

Gospel According to Mark 2 Weeks

Key Concepts: Ministry of John the Baptist, Christian Service, Miracles, Passion of Christ, Textual Variants.

Assessments: Unit Test, 2 Memory Verse Quizzes (Mark 10:45, Mark 16:15-16).

Second Quarter – Luke / Acts and Romans

Gospel According to Luke 3 Weeks

Key Concepts: Gentiles, Temptation, Compassion, The Transfiguration, Chronology of Jesus' Life and Ministry.

Assessments: Unit Test, Timeline of Jesus' Ministry, Memory Verse Quiz (Luke 19:9-10).

The Book of Acts 2.5 Weeks

Key Concepts: Person and Work of the Holy Spirit, Pentecost, Foundation of the Church, Saul's Conversion, Jerusalem Council, Christian Missions, Persecution, Martyrdom.

Assessments: Unit Test, Memory Verse Quizzes (Acts 1:8, Acts 2:42), Map Project – Paul's Missionary Journeys.

Romans 2.5 Weeks

Key Concepts: 1st Century Rome, Righteousness, Faith, The Law, Sin, Salvation, Justification, Sanctification, God's Future for Israel, Human Government.

Assessments: Unit Test, Memory Verse Quizzes (Romans 3:23-24, Romans 5:8-9, Romans 6:22-23, Romans 10:9-10), Vocabulary Quiz

Assessments: First Semester Final Exam

Third Quarter – Pauline Epistles

The Ministries of Peter and Paul 1 Week

Key Concepts: Compare / Contrast the lives and ministries of Peter and Paul.

Assessments: Completion of Peter and Paul video activity.

1 and 2 Corinthians 3 Weeks

Key Concepts: Church Conduct & Discipline, Spiritual Gifts, Love, Paul's Personal Integrity, Giving.

Assessments: Unit Test, Theme Paper – Spiritual Gifts, 2 Memory Verse Quizzes (1 Corinthians 13:4-5, 6-7).

Galatians, Ephesians, Philippians, Colossians, Philemon 3 Weeks

Key Concepts: Ministry of the Church, Humility, Sufficiency and Preeminence of Christ, Equality.

Assessments: Unit Test, Memory Verse Quizzes (Galatians 5:22-23, Ephesians 2:8-9, Philippians 4:8).

1 and 2 Thessalonians / Eschatology 1 Week

Key Concepts: The End of the Age, Judgment, Encouragement, Perseverance.

Assessments: Memory Verse Quiz (I Thessalonians 4:16-17).

1 and 2 Timothy, Titus 1 Week

Key Concepts: Mentoring, Qualifications for Leadership, Pastoral Ministry, Church Officers.

Assessments: Unit Test, Memory Verse Quiz (2 Timothy 3:16-17).

Fourth Quarter – General Epistles

Hebrews 1 Week

Key Concepts: Jesus as Prophet, Priest, and King; Superiority of Christ; Faith; The Communion of Saints.

Assessments: Essay – Compare / Contrast Jesus and the Old Testament Priesthood. Memory Verse Quiz (Hebrews 11:1-2).

The Gospel According to John 3 Weeks

Key Concepts: The “I AM” Statements of Jesus. Jesus’ Teachings to the Twelve, Passion Week.

Assessments: Unit Test, 2 Memory Verse Quizzes (John 1:14, John 15:5-6).

James 1 Week

Key Concepts: Faith, Faith vs. Works, Christian Conduct.

Assessments: Mini Test.

1 and 2 Peter, 1 thru 3 John, Jude 1 Week

Key Concepts: Christian Suffering, Submission, Christian Character, False Teachers, The Return of Christ, Love.

Assessments: Mini Test, 2 Memory Verse Quizzes (1 Peter 4:16 & 19, 1 John 4:7-8).

The Revelation 2 Weeks

Key Concepts: The End of the Age, Judgment, The Seven Churches of Asia, 4 Views of Revelation.

Assessments: Unit Test, 7 Churches of Asia Map Activity, Memory Verse Quiz (Revelation 7:10).

Key Concepts: Review

Assessments: Second Semester Final Exam
