This course will include an intensive grammar study with a focus on application of grammar rules, especially on usage and mechanics. Other areas covered will be two novel studies, the components of a short story, poetry, and drama; vocabulary and spelling program with an emphasis on usage; an emphasis on the writing process, paragraph development, and the multi-paragraph essay using numerous writing activities, including a research paper.
