COURSE SCOPE AND SEQUENCE

First Semester

Present Tense, Pronouns, and Possession 2 Weeks

Key Concepts: Review of Simple Present Tense, Present Continuous Tense;

Subject & Object Pronouns, Possessive Adjectives, and Time Expressions

Assessments: Written and Oral Activities Describing Habitual and Ongoing Activities, Telling About Likes and Dislikes, Describing Frequency of Actions, Telling About Personal Background and Interests

Biblical Integration: Conversation Regarding Churches In Country of Origin.

Past Tense 1 Week

Key Concepts: Review of Simple Past Tense (Regular and Irregular Verbs) and Past Continuous Tense

Assessments: Written and Oral Activities Reporting Past Activities, Mishaps, Difficult Experiences, and Describing A Trip

Biblical Integration: God's Help With Bad Experiences

Future Tense, Time, and Possession 2 Weeks

Key Concepts: Review of Future: Going To, Future: Will, Future Continuous Tense, Time Expressions, Possessive Pronouns

Assessments: Written and Oral Activities Describing Future Plans and Intentions, Telling About the Future, Expressing Time and Duration, Talking on the Telephone, Plans for the Future, and Asking A Favor

Biblical Integration: God's Guidance for the Future. Jer.29:11

Present Perfect Tense 2 Weeks

Key Concepts: Present Perfect Tense

Assessments: Written and Oral Activities Describing Actions That Have Occurred, Describing Actions That Haven't Occurred Yet, Making Recommendations, Things to Do Where You Live, and Making Lists

Biblical Integration: Conversation and Plans for Christian Service.

Perfect, Present, and Past Tenses 2 Weeks

Key Concepts: Present Perfect Vs. Present Tense, Present Perfect Vs. Past Tense, Since/For

Assessments: Written and Oral Activities Discussing Duration of Activity, Medical Symptoms and Problems, Career Advancements, Telling About Family Members

Biblical Integration: Jesus, the Great Physician, John 9.

More Present Tense 2 Weeks

Key Concepts: Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Assessments: Written and Oral Activities Discussing Duration of Activity, Reporting Household Repair Problems, Describing Tasks Accomplished, Reassuring Someone, Describing Experiences, Job Interviews

Biblical Integration: Written Composition on Personal Walk With Christ.

Gerunds and Infinitives 2 Weeks

Key Concepts: Gerunds, Infinitives; Review of Present Perfect and Present Perfect Continuous Tenses

Assessments: Written and Oral Activities Discussing Recreation Preferences, Discussing Things You Dislike Doing, Habits, Describing Talents and Skills, Telling About Important Decisions

Biblical Integration: Discuss 1 Corinthians 12.

More Past Tense 2 Weeks

Key Concepts: Past Perfect Tense, Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Assessments: Written and Oral Activities Discussing Things People Had Done, Discussing Preparations for Events, Describing Consequences of Being Late, Discussing Feelings, Describing Accomplishments

Biblical Integration: Discuss Luke 12 and Mt. 25.

Two-Word Verbs 1 Week

Key Concepts: Two-Word Verbs: Separable and Inseparable

Assessments: Written and Oral Activities Discussing When Things Are Going to Happen, Remembering and Forgetting, Discussing Obligations, Asking for and Giving Advice, School Assignments, Making Plans By Telephone, Talking About Important People In Your Life, Shopping for Clothing

Biblical Integration: Role Play Witnessing to Important People In Your Life.

Connectors 2 Weeks

Key Concepts: and . . . Too, and . . . Either; So, But, Neither

Assessments: Written and Oral Activities About Coincidences, Asking for and Giving Reasons; Describing People's Backgrounds, Interest, and Personalities; Looking for A Job, Referring People to Someone Else, Discussing Opinions, and Describing People's Similarities and Differences.

Biblical Integration: Study of Psalm 139.

Writing and Comprehension Skills (Concurrent With Grammar) 18 Weeks

Key Concepts: Items In A Series, Semicolon Construction, Appositives, Participial Phrases, Present Participle, The Writing Process.

Second Semester

Review 2 Weeks

Key Concepts: Present Perfect Tense, Present Perfect Continuous Tense, Past Perfect Tense, Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Assessments: Written and Oral Activities Describing Actions That Have Occurred, Describing Actions That Haven't Occurred Yet, Discussing Duration of Activity, and Discussing Things People Had Done.

Biblical Integration: Discussion of Psalm 138.

Perfect Modals 2 Weeks

Key Concepts: Should Have, Might Have, May Have Could Have, Must Have

Assessments: Written and Oral Activities Evaluating People's Activities, Job Interviews, Expressing Possibility, Making Deductions, Expressing Concern About Others, Apologizing, and Recounting Difficult Situations.

Biblical Integration: Mt. 6:8-14 Learn Lord's Prayer In English.

Passive Voice & Relative Pronouns 2 Weeks

Key Concepts: Use of the Passive Voice and Relative Pronouns

Assessments: Written and Oral Activities Discussing Creative Works, Describing Tasks Accomplished, Discussing Things That Have Happened to People, Describing Accomplishments, Securing Services, Automobile Repairs, Historical Narratives, and Discussing Opinions.

Biblical Integration: Story of Joseph, Gen 39-49.

Embedded Questions 1 Week

Key Concepts: Asking and Answering Questions In Public

Assessments: Written and Oral Activities Asking for Information, Indicating Uncertainty, Referring People to Someone Else, Reporting A Crime, Reporting A Missing Person

Biblical Integration: Proverbs 3:5

Conditional Expressions 2 Weeks

Key Concepts: Present Real (If __ Will), Present Unreal (If __ Would), Hope-Clauses
Assessments: Written and Oral Activities Describing Plans and Intentions, Consequences of Actions, Discussing Future Events, Expressing Hopes, Asking for and Giving Reasons, Making Deductions, and Emergencies
Biblical Integration: Romans 12:12.

Conditional Expressions (Cont.) 2 Weeks

Key Concepts: Present Unreal Conditional, Wish-Clauses
Assessments: Written and Oral Activities Regarding Advice, Expressing Wishes, Job Satisfaction, Expressing Ability, Asking for and Giving Reasons, Life In Cities and Suburbs
Biblical Integration: Isaiah 6

Conditional Expressions (Cont.) 2 Weeks

Key Concepts: Past Unreal Conditional (If __ Would Have), Wish-Clauses (Cont.)
Assessments: Written and Oral Activities Asking for and Giving Reasons, Making Deductions, Discussing Unexpected Events, Expressing Wishes and Hopes, Consequences of Actions, and Rumors
Biblical Integration: Isaiah 55

Reporting and Tenses 2 Weeks

Key Concepts: Reported Speech and Sequence of Tenses
Assessments: Written and Oral Activities Reporting What People Have Said, Reporting Information, Expressing Surprise, Indicating Lack of Prior Knowledge; Leaving, Taking, and Conveying Messages; Job Interviews, Asking for and Giving Reasons, Discussing Feelings, and Advice
Biblical Integration: Luke 1:46-55.

Questions and Emphatics 1 Week

Key Concepts: Tag Questions and Emphatic Sentences
Assessments: Written and Oral Activities for Verifying, Expressing Surprise, Reporting Information, Congratulating, Initiating Topics, Expressing Opinions, Expressing Agreement, Writing A Personal Letter, Writing A Business Memo, and Performance on the Job
Biblical Integration: Write A Letter to A Friend Sharing A Favorite Bible Verse.

Review 2 Weeks

Key Concepts: Verb Tenses, Conditionals, Gerunds
Assessments: Written and Oral Activities for Making Invitations, Expressing Disappointment, Calling Attention to People's Actions, Apologizing, Giving Reasons, Decision-Making, Consequences of Actions, Expressing Concern About People, Asking for Assistance.
Biblical Integration: Psalm 121

Writing and Comprehension Skills (Concurrent With Grammar) 18 Weeks

Key Concepts: Participial Phrases, Past Participle, Subordinate Clauses, Relative Clauses, The Writing Process.

Assessments: *Easy Writing* Worksheets, Evaluation and Editing of Other Content Area Assignments, Reading and Writing.
