

# Phoenix Christian High School SST500 Student Council Course Scope & Sequence (2010)

## **COURSE DESCRIPTION**

The Student Active Leadership Training/Team (SALT) is a program designed to disciple the student leader in his/her discovery of the connection between spiritual intimacy and action in regards to Christian leadership and impact/influence upon others. The student leader will explore the idea of spiritual formation and its connection with servant leadership. The course will be a hybrid of corporate exploration of spiritual formation topics as it relates to Christian leadership and the practical student administration of various programs impacting campus culture and community outreach. The (SALT) team will serve much like a traditional Student Council with elected positions and responsibilities for events, programming, and budgeting.

## **BIBLICAL INTEGRATION**

The student leader is expected to embrace the model of Christian character in the reflection of Christ. The student leader is expected to adhere to the following standards as stated in the SALT Constitution (Article 1, Section 2).

- G. To promote and practice democratic government and living
- H. To promote the general welfare of Phoenix Christian High School
