### Course Scope & Sequence (2010)

#### **COURSE DESCRIPTION**

8<sup>th</sup> grade Art is an introduction to basic procedures in the artistic areas of drawing, color, tempera painting, and clay. Students will receive 'hands on' experience in all areas, and be guided to improve their standards of aesthetic judgment. Through personal application, Art will no longer be an "I can't" situation for the student, but an "I can" expression of life. Students with a new skill and interest will be encouraged to move on to the next step of learning, High School Art I.

#### **COURSE SCOPE AND SEQUENCE**

##### Drawing

---

*Key Concepts:* Left Brain and Right Brain Thinking, Creative Thinking, Viewing Shapes by Working with Contour Lines, Drawing Objects with a Three-Dimensional Look through Shading, Drawing and Shading a Still Life, Using Charcoal and Pastels to Show Dimension and Color.

*Assessments:* Completion of the Project, Neatness, Goal Accomplishment, Effort, and Use of Class Time and Resources.

*Biblical Integration:* Using all the parts of the brain God gave us to learn how to copy God's creations.

##### Color

---

*Key Concepts:* Understanding Relationships between Colors, Identifying Complementary Colors, Primary Colors, Mixing colors, Blending Colors on Paper Using Pastels, The Color Wheel.

*Assessments:* Color Wheel Test. Completion of the Project, Neatness, Goal Accomplishment, Effort, and Use of Class Time and Resources.

*Biblical Integration:* We explore the amazing world of color and how to apply it to try to match the many colors of Gods' world. (Ezekial 1)

##### Collage

---

*Key Concepts:* Learning about different Artists and their story behind the Art work.

*Assessment:* Students will give an oral and written report about the artist and the piece of art they have selected. Students will complete a magazine paper collage of the art work and present it along with their report to the class.

*Biblical Integration:* God is a creative being. We need to celebrate the creativity in ourselves and in others by learning about their works and how God has used them to bless us with their creative beauty.
