Course Scope & Sequence (2010)

**COURSE DESCRIPTION** The main goal of New Testament Survey, is to address the Gospel of Christ in a real and informative format. Time is spent learning the basic themes of the Books of the Bible as well as examining the last week of Jesus' earthly life and impact on His people today. The 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester deals with the rise of the Church as found in Acts. The final month deals with practical "Where the Rubber Meets the Road" Christianity: know the faith and Apologetics. Community service is required by the school and tracked in Bible class at 10 hours per semester.

**COURSE SCOPE AND SEQUENCE**

**First Semester - Gospel Focus**

O.T. Review/ Inter-Testamental Period, 2 Weeks

*Key Concepts:* Historical Overview of the Israel Prior to the Gospels, Prophetic hope, Kingdom of God, Messianic Hope, History of time between the testaments: Greek and Roman empires

*Assessments:* Reading Quizzes, Books of the Bible Quizzes, Memory Verse/Vocabulary Quizzes, Video Notes, Tests,

Intro to the Gospels, Mark, Books of the Bible 4 Weeks

*Key Concepts:* How the Bible Came Into Existence, The Validity of the Bible, Mark: Jesus announcement of Kingdom of God, Pharisees, "Jewish Messiah", Basic overall story of Jesus life, and death

*Assessments:* Reading Quizzes, Books of the Bible Quizzes, Memory Verse Quizzes, Participation.

Matthew 3 Weeks

*Key Concepts:* harmonize birth story, Baptism, Temptation, Sermon on the Mount,

*Assessments:* Reading Quizzes, Books of the Bible Quizzes, Memory Verse Quizzes, Participation.

Luke, 3 Weeks

*Key Concepts:* Parables, Miracles, Teachings of Jesus

*Assessments:* Reading Quizzes, Books of the Bible Quizzes, Memory Verse Quizzes, Participation.

4 Weeks

*Key Concepts:* Detailed blow by blow look into the last week of Jesus. Conflict with Jewish leaders, resurrection of Lazarus, Last Supper, betrayal, trial and crucifixion, emphasis on resurrection and great commission.

*Assessments:* Cooperative Learning Activities, Reading Quizzes, Memory Verse/Vocabulary Quizzes, Books of the Bible Quizzes, Tests

## **Second Semester - Acts and the Church**

Acts,

10 Weeks

*Key Concepts:* History of the Church, Pentecost, Message of the Gospel, Persecution of the Church, Spreading of the Gospel, inclusion of Gentiles, Missionary journeys Geography and Historical Context, Key problem: how do Jews and Gentiles get along? Key Individuals (Paul, Peter, James), Jerusalem Council.

*Assessments:* Reading Quizzes, Memory Verse/Vocabulary Quizzes, Tests, Maps, Mini-Projects.

### **“Rubber Meets the Road” Christianity**

Living the Christian Life/Apologetics

5 Weeks

*Key Concepts:* Application of Biblical Principles and Ethics, Situational Ethics/Personal Responsibility. Focus on Christian World View vs. non-Christian World view. Sharing and knowing Your Faith.

*Assessments:* Reading Quizzes, Memory Verse/Vocabulary Quizzes, Debates, Project, Tests.
