

Phoenix Christian Jr High School HEC0720 Beginning Sewing Course Scope & Sequence (2010)

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Students will learn basic hand stitching and beginning machine sewing. WE will design and hand stitch a pincushion and a furry pillow or stuffed animal. Students will also learn the parts and correct use of a sewing machine and sew pajama pants or a locker organizer.

REQUIRED MATERIALS

One pocket folder (for handouts)

The kits and fabric will be purchased through the instructor.

COURSE SCOPE AND SEQUENCE

One Semester Course

First Quarter

Unit: Hand Stitching 9 Weeks

Key Concepts: Basic Hand Stitches: Running, Loop, Herringbone, Backstitch, and Overcast Stitches.

Assessments: Quizzes, Homework, Skill Checks, and Projects (pincushion and fur project).

Second Quarter

Unit: Machine Sewing 9 Weeks

Key Concepts: Threading and Running a Sewing Machine. Sewing Lines, Corners, Curves, and Back Stitches

Assessments: Quizzes, Sewing on Paper packet, Machine Sewn Pants or Locker Organizer.
