Dress Code

Middle School/High School

Below is a condensed version of the Dress Code for 2020-2021.

Please see the 2020-2021 Parent-Student Handbook for the comprehensive listing of the dress code.

Shirts:

- Students are required to wear a solid polo shirt while on campus and during school hours Monday-Friday.
- Friday's students may wear official PC Spirit Wear shirts.

Shorts:

- Shorts must be denim (blue or black) or *uniform-style* shorts in the following colors: khaki or black. Shorts may not be frayed or torn. Cut-offs are unacceptable. No athletic wear is allowed.

Jeans/Pants/Slacks/Capris:

- Bottoms must be denim (blue or black) or *uniform-style* pants in the following colors: khaki or black. May not be frayed or torn even if skin is not visible through the holes. No athletic wear including yoga pants is allowed.

Skirts:

- Skirts must be denim (blue or black) or in the following colors: Khaki or black. Skirts including slits, may be no shorter than three (3) inches above the kneecap.
- Dresses should not be worn during the academic school day unless given special permission by administration.

Footwear:

- Tennis shoes, dress shoes, and sandals are acceptable.

Outerwear (jackets, sweatshirts):

- Students must wear official **Phoenix Christian Preparatory School** outerwear.

Hats/Caps/Beanies/Headbands/Hoods:

- May not be worn during regular school hours.

Hair & Make-Up:

- Hair for males must be above the middle of the ear, the eyebrows and the collar. Male students must be clean-shaven; beards, and goatees are not permitted. Male students will likely be required to shave (during the school day if out of dress code).

Jewelry/Tattoos:

- Earrings are acceptable for females only. If males have pierced ears, they may not wear earrings during the school day regardless if they are covered or not.
- Tattoos must be covered at all times.
