# Dress Code

## Middle School/High School

Below is a condensed version of the Dress Code for 2022-2023.

### Shirts:

- Students are required to wear a solid polo shirt while on campus and during school hours Monday-Friday.
- Fridays students may wear official PC Spirit Wear shirts with jeans or uniform style shorts/pants/skirts.
- *For the 2023-24 school year, students will be required to wear a BLACK, GREEN, WHITE, GRAY, or PINK solid-colored polo shirt (Phoenix Christian logo preferred).*

### Jean/Pants/Slacks/Capris/Shorts:

- Bottoms must be denim (blue or black) or *uniform-style* in the following colors: khaki or black.
- May not be frayed or torn even if skin is not visible through the holes.
- No athletic wear, including yoga pants/leggings, is allowed.
- Cut-offs are unacceptable.

### Skirts:

- Skirts must be denim (blue or black) or in the following colors: khaki or black. Skirts including slits, may be no shorter than three (3) inches above the kneecap.
- Dresses should not be worn during the academic school day unless given special permission by administration.

### Footwear:

- Tennis shoes, dress shoes, and sandals are acceptable. No slippers.

### Outerwear (Jackets/Sweatshirts):

- Students must wear official Phoenix Christian Preparatory School outerwear.
- Blankets are NOT considered outerwear. Therefore, students should not utilize or have blankets in class or on campus.

### Hats/Caps/Beanies/Hoods:

- May not be worn during regular school hours – no other headwear (such as bandanas) may be worn.

### Hair & Make-Up:

- Hair, whether natural, dyed, or colored, must remain a natural color.
- Hair for males must be off the ears, off the collar, and off the eyebrows. A hair tie will be required if hair is kept long. Male students must be clean-shaven; beards, mustaches, and goatees are not permitted. Male students will likely be required to shave (during the school day if not compliant with the dress code policy).

### Jewelry/Tattoos:

- Earrings are acceptable for females only. If males have pierced ears, they may not wear earrings during regular school hours.
- No other body piercing is allowed.
- Tattoos must be covered at all times.
